Over 500 Now Registered For FS-ISAC CAPP Exercise

Registration is now open for the Cyber Attack against Payment Processes (CAPP) Exercise. Over 500 organizations have registered for the three-day exercise, which will be held February 9-11, 2010. The exercise is a simulation and not a penetration test or actual event. Registrants will receive an email on each of the three days during the exercise, which will contain the details of a simulated attack scenario and associated questions. They will then respond by 5:00pm local time daily to the questions via an online survey tool called Survey Monkey. It is anticipated that the exercise will not take more than an hour to complete each day. This valuable exercise will provide organizations with the opportunity to evaluate their current risk mitigation procedures related to cyber attacks and identify potential critical gaps in planning. All participants will receive an after-action report with best practices and mitigation techniques. Participation is **FREE** and is open to all financial institutions, card processors, third party ACH service providers, retailers and corporate treasurers.
